Theodore Stubbs was elected mayor of Galveston in May, 1962, the second mayor to serve under the council form of government. He had been a member of the City Charter Commission, which drafted the city manager-council government for the city in 1959-60, and he had been elected to the first council. This accession includes only his mayoral records, though some of the files include material from his council service.

As a partner in the law firm of Markwell and Stubbs, Stubbs was involved in several interesting cases. The Texas City disaster case files comprising a series of lawsuits stemming from the refinery explosions in April, 1947, make up the bulk of this accession. Other cases deal with airport land, the J. Z. H. Scott residence and Stewart Beach.

This accession is a merger of recently donated records and all those previously accessioned as #77-0024, Texas City Disaster Legal Papers, and #79-0006, Theodore B. Stubbs Mayoral Papers.
