These are records of fires in Galveston. They provide data including date, how the alarm was placed, time, name of owner, name of occupant, class of building, use of building, cause of fire, value of buildings, amount of damage, amount of insurance carried, amount paid, feet of hose used, companies responding, feet of ladders used, gallons of chemicals used, and remarks.

This collection is divided into two parts. Records through October 1952 are stored on the oversize manuscripts shelf in the archives vault. Records after October 1952 are stored in the New Attic cage.

The records of fires, 1900-1920 and 1936-1942, were not received from the Galveston Fire Department.
